PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector for the township of Ypsilanti in the state of Michigan who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township Clerk.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 19, 2020**

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at their city/township of residency at the following places, days and times:
